Post Baccalaureate Certificate in Accounting Technology

This program is designed to be completed in 12-18 months.

(most students work full time and can take classes at their own pace causing this program to take longer in most cases)

This program is 21 hours in length plus a technology accounting-related certification.

This program will cost \$[14,396] if completed within normal time. There may be additional costs for living expenses. These costs were accurate at the time of posting, but may have changed.

Program requires that students earn some accounting-related technologically specific certification, but the program does not define what certification the student chooses. Most students will pursue a Microsoft Excel, Quickbooks, or work-related general ledger program certification. These certifications have equivalent requirements across all states and would be applicable or usable in all states
