ULM LIBRARY

- The library has been around since the university's beginnings in 1931. The current library building opened in 1999.
- The library occupies the first five floors; the sixth and seventh contain the offices of the university administration, including the Office of the President.

1ST FLOOR



The Circulation Desk is where you can check out books, chargers, study rooms, and more.



The Computer Lab offers students access to the internet and various software programs.

2ND FLOOR



The second floor has more computers and serves as a community space for students, faculty, and staff.



The second floor also houses study rooms, the Reference Librarians, and the combined office of Government Publications/Serials and Media.

3RD FLOOR



The third floor provides several study areas, including carrels and group study areas. The third floor is also where you will find LC call numbers A-P, and classrooms 3-A through 3-G.



The third floor houses the ULM Moodle Help Desk and the ULM IT Department.

4TH FLOOR



The fourth floor is where you will find LC call numbers Q-Z, the Curriculum & Juvenile Collection, and Library Technical Services.



Much like the third floor, the fourth floor provides different study areas and study rooms. However, the fourth floor is a quiet study area.

5TH FLOOR

The fifth floor is the quietest of the floors. It houses study areas, including rooms and carrels.



The fifth floor also houses the special collection department and some faculty offices.
