- 1. Throws: Individually wrapped candy, beads, cups, and balloons are encouraged. Try to stay away from suckers and hard candy as it poses safety issues when thrown.
- 2. Absolutely no horses, cattle, or livestock allowed.
- 3.NO ALCOHOL! In compliance with City of Monroe Ordinance and the University of Louisiana Monroe policy, no alcohol possession or consumption is allowed during any aspect of the parade. Police will enforce this regulation.
- 4.Only properly registered vehicles operated and insured by a licensed adult driver (18 years and older) will be permitted in the parade.
- 5. Anyone caught using profanity or obscene gestures will be removed from the parade. LOW VOLUME MUSIC until 5:15pm in line-up, appropriate for all audiences.
- 6.All participants must comply with parade officials, volunteers, and law enforcement personnel.
- 7. Absolutely no all-terrain vehicles such as four-wheelers and gators will be permitted in the parade (except those being used by law enforcement), this includes road legal motorcycles.
- ** Elevated speed humps along route, approximately 6"-8" tall; please take note for floats and trailers
- ** Designated stops for performance of bands & dance teams will be announced once registration is confirmed
