Department Heads Meeting

May 12, 2011

The meeting was called to order by Dean Cass at 3:30 PM in the Arts and Sciences Conference Room, ADMN 1-47. All heads were present. Dr. Michael Camille was absent. The following items were discussed.

1. Welcome

- Dean Cass welcomed Heads

2. College Business

- Textbook Debacle: The Bookstore uploaded fall 2010 data instead of fall 2011 data for textbook request.
- Spending Freeze: For the next 5 weeks, purchase or pay for only things that cannot wait until the next fiscal year for example: Social Work accreditation.
- Assuming a \$10 million cut, with a \$3.1 million subsidy from state, use of \$3 million in reserves, and \$2 million in carry over from this year, the College of Arts and Sciences may have a ½ million dollar cut for fiscal year 2011-2012. Note that \$6 million of these funds are not recurring and will have to be dealt with in 2012-13.
- Numbers for Maymester, Summer, and Fall courses: Minimum numbers for a class to make is 10.
- Directed Study: Student/faculty ratio is affected by directed study courses.

3. President's Award for Excellence

- In addition to faculty, department heads are eligible to be nominated for the President Award for Excellence.

4. Strategic Plan

- Please turn in strategic plan for your department if you have not done so.

5. Board Core

 ULM core requirement will be the same as the Board of Regents core requirement with one exception. 3 hours of the 9 hours of humanities requirement must be a literature course.

6. Grad Act

- Please finish responses and submit them by the deadline. The college retention rate is 72.5%. However the graduation rate is 29%.
- Limiting the number of drops allowed to a student and instituting a drop fee were discussed.

7. UG degrees (120, 30 in major

 All degrees must be lowered to 120 hours with 30 hours in the major or department head must provide substantial reason for not getting to 120 hours.

8. Adjournment

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 4:20 PM.
