Professional Semester 1: CURR 375A, CURR 303, and CURR 302 are scheduled as a 12 hours per week block in which candidates teach 60 hours in middle/high schools during the semester.

Professional Semester 2: READ 418A and CURR 304 are scheduled as a 6 hour block in which candidates teach 40 hours in middle/high schools during the semester. CURR 483 is a secondary focus area placement with a certified classroom supervisor at a middle/high school site. CURR 483 includes 100 clock hours with 80 hours of direct teaching activities.
