On Monday, May 2, the Division of Music will present the thirty-first annual Honors Recital. Each student chosen to perform on this prestigious concert will also receive a performer's certificate from the Division of Music.

The competition is open to any music major attending ULM as a full-time student. (twelve hours-undergraduate/nine hours-graduate) The student must have a recommendation signature from his or her major applied teacher. Last year's winners may not audition, unless auditioning in a different performance area. A student may only audition in one performance area each year. Each winner must perform the same selection on the recital that was performed at the audition.

Musical selections must not exceed nine minutes. A single-movement work that exceeds the time limit may be allowed, with prior permission from Dr. Lunte. Performances during the audition process may be cut short due to time.

There will be a maximum of seven performers chosen for the recital, although less may be chosen. Each candidate will be judged by the highest artistic standards in regards to musicianship and general stage presentation. Auditions will be closed.
