UNDERGRADUATE ADMISSIONS APPEAL

The University of Louisiana at Monroe is committed to your success as an adult learner. In educating adults, it is our belief that students who have worked full-time for at least three years will be best prepared to participate meaningfully in the ULM online degree program. We realize, however, that some students who lack three years of full-time post-high school work experience may have other personal or professional experiences that will enable them to participate in a ULM online degree program. If you are an applicant who fits this description, you may request special consideration of your application by telling us how you believe your work experiences prepare you for the ULM online degree programs.

To facilitate this request, please submit all transcripts of your undergraduate coursework, or high school transcript if you do not have any college credit. In addition to the transcripts please prepare a letter that includes information about:

- *Your work history*
- *The nature and scope of your work responsibilities*
- *Two or three significant insights that your work experiences have provided*
- *How you believe your work and other experiences prepare you to be successful in the ULM GOLD program*
