Issue	Results	Comments
Develop a course content review plan	A course content review plan was approved on 4/14/15 after several rounds of revision.	A plan was decided on by the committee to pilot the review process on two courses-- Patho I and Respiratory module. Those reviews were completed in addition to a review for Neuro/Psych. After the pilot reviews a few changes have been made but a process is in place now that appears to be effective to complete a course review on selected P1 courses and modules this year.
Removal of PHRD 5033 co-requisite from PHRD 5027 and PHRD 5035 to assist progression of modified P3s and change in pre-requisites and co-requisites for PHRD 5068	The committee passed a motion to remove 5033 as a pre-req for 5027 and 5035 on 11/11/14 and 12/10/14 (by virtual vote), respectively. The 5068 changes were approved by virtual vote on 1/20/15.	The suggested changes passed UCC at the February, 2015 meeting.
Approval of new course: Acute Care Family Medicine	The committee passed a motion to approve the new course at the 12/9/14 meeting.	The course passed UCC at the February, 2015 meeting
Deletion of Graduate Courses	A request to delete from the catalog PHAR graduate courses no longer being taught passed the committee on 4/28/15.	The changes were approved by UCC at the May, 2015 meeting.
