

PROVISIONAL ENTRY PROGRAM

SECURE YOUR PLACE IN ULM'S SCHOOL OF PHARMACY

The Provisional Entry Program is ULM's unique program for academically superior high school students interested in a pharmacy career. It eliminates the worry of acceptance into Pharmacy School, as long as the required criteria are met throughout the ULM pre-pharmacy period.

PEP Advantages

Eligibility Requirements:

- Must be a high school senior at an accredited U.S. high school;
- Must have a 3.8 cumulative high school GPA (4.0 scale);
- Have a minimum composite score of 27 on the ACT.
- Must attend ULM for the pre-pharmacy curriculum.

Students can avoid the competitive selection process for admissions into the professional pharmacy program.

Provides students the opportunity engage in personal and professional relationships with School of Pharmacy faculty and upperclassmen immediately upon entering ULM as a freshman.

Gives students the opportunity to participate in professional student pharmacist organizations and leadership development programs earlier in their collegiate careers.

PEP students are invited to attend School of Pharmacy events such as Boo-n-Bop, Pharmal, Rx Rally, etc.
