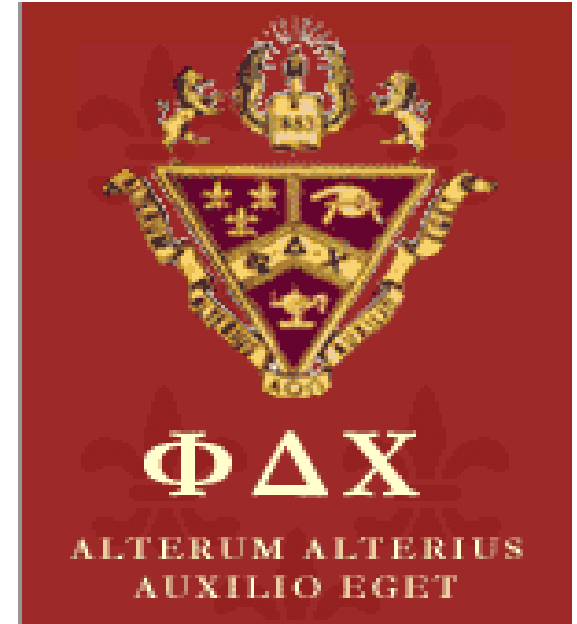

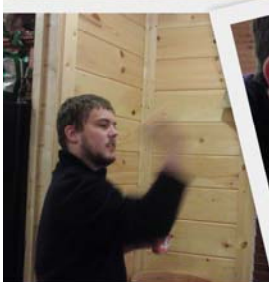
Our Pledges at Homecoming

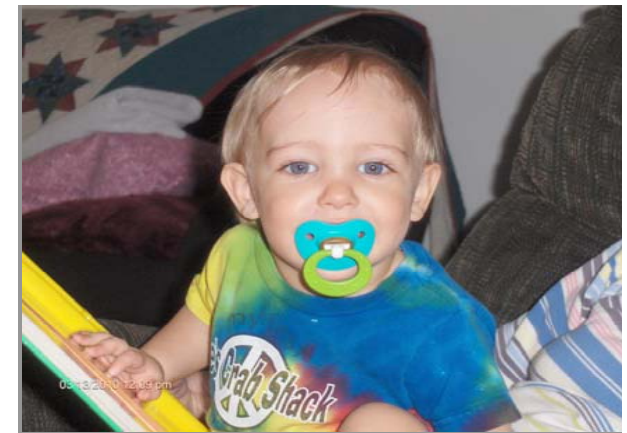
