

**Pharmacy Student Senate
Meeting Minutes
March 2, 2009**

- **Students Surfing the Web:** Dr. Leader doesn't want to block websites in the pharmacy building. Students should be personally responsible for paying attention in class. If students are being disturbed by others, they should speak with them or speak to the professor.
- **Moving Tests:** 90% of students voting one way or the other will decide the vote. Certain things should be taken into consideration, such as off-track students having more than one test in a day. Clickers should be used so that all votes are anonymous.
