RE: Mobility Impaired Parking Permits

Enclosed is a new **Application for Mobility Impaired Parking Permit** at the University of Louisiana at Monroe. Please read this form carefully before completing to ensure all items are answered correctly in accordance to *Louisiana Revised statute 47:463.4 states as follows: "person with a disability" means a person so severely impaired that such person is unable to move from place to place without the aid of a mechanical device...*

Furthermore, "any medical examiner who willfully and falsely certifies that a person is mobility-impaired in order to allow that person to obtain the special license plate, hang tag, or mobility-impaired identification card authorized in this Section shall be fined one thousand dollars, or shall be imprisoned for not more than ninety days, or both."

Patient must return the form to University Police by February 6, 2004, or parking privileges will be rescinded until said application is returned as stated above.
