

# Tobacco Use Policy

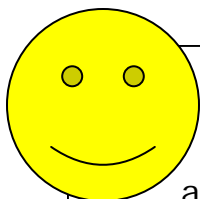
The University of Louisiana at Monroe is committed to promoting and maintaining a healthy work and academic environment.

Policy applies to *ALL* University students, faculty, staff, visitors, and contractors.

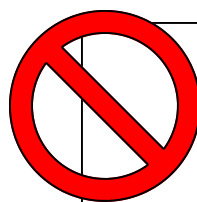


## Tobacco Use Includes

- Smoking tobacco (cigars, cigarettes, & pipes)
- Smokeless tobacco (dipping and chewing)



Tobacco use is permitted only within designated areas. Each designated area is defined as the 10 ft radius surrounding each tobacco waste receptacle. Each receptacle will be fixed in place at a minimum distance of 35 ft from any University building.



The use of tobacco products is prohibited in:

- ✓ All University buildings and leased spaces
- ✓ All University vehicles
- ✓ All outdoor areas where seating is provided.
