- Army ROTC is a **Leadership** program that involves elective courses and activities, which students take in conjunction with their other classes. Students do not have to join the military to take the basic level classes. Students can take these classes as electives—these classes are success oriented.
- The Basic Course encompasses the first two years of the program for non-prior service students. **THERE IS NO MILITARY OBLIGATION WHEN A STUDENT ENROLLS IN THE 100 OR 200 LEVEL MILITARY SCIENCE COURSES—IT IS SIMPLY A LEADERSHIP/ADVENTURE TRAINING COURSE!**
- Corporate America is looking for bright young leaders. ROTC will enhance your communication skills, self confidence, physical fitness, and self discipline.
- The Reserve Officer Training Corps (ROTC) offers a variety of 2, 3 and 4 year scholarships.
- The scholarships offered pay up to \$80,000 in tuition and fees, plus the following:
 - a. Book allowance of \$1200 per year
 - b. Room and board
 - c. Monthly stipend of \$300 Freshman year, \$350 Sophomore year, \$450 Junior year, and \$500 Senior year.
 - d. Foreign language incentive of \$100 for Freshman level language, \$150 for Sophomore level, \$200 for Junior level, and \$250 for Senior level per month
- ROTC also offers a number of programs for those students interested in nursing, plus there is a program for students working towards a Master’s degree.
- There are even special programs for veterans of our Armed services, including the Simultaneous Membership Program and Reserve Force Duty or Dedicated National Guard Scholarship. Soldiers on Active Duty or Reserve who have served at least 50% of their present contract can apply for the Green to Gold (GTG) scholarship.
