(Doctor of Education Degree)

The Doctor of Education degree in Curriculum and Instruction or Educational Leadership is offered through the cooperative effort of Grambling State University, Louisiana Tech University, and The University of Louisiana at Monroe and coordinated through the Louisiana Education Consortium Governing Board. All consortium institutions will offer foundation courses and other graduate courses required in the Ed.D. program in Curriculum and Instruction or Educational Leadership based on faculty expertise and other institutional resources. The Doctor of Education degree will be awarded by the institution to which the student has been admitted for doctoral study with course work being completed on all three campuses in order to provide diverse academic experiences. A unique strength of the Louisiana Education Consortium is that the three institutions will strategically pool faculty, equipment, and technology.

The programs are designed for K-12 personnel, including teachers and administrators. The primary goal of the doctoral program is the preparation of practitioner scholars for roles in elementary, middle, and secondary school settings.
