NEW LATE PAYMENT FEE POLICY

Please read the below information carefully!

Students will not be dropped for non-payment; however; students with a balance after the fee payment deadlines will be charged a late payment fee. Students will be responsible for any tuition and fees for classes that remain on your schedule and/or room, meals and any miscellaneous charges on their account after the fee payment deadline. Students who are recipients of scholarships, TOPS, National Guard, financial aid, waivers or any special program must have all required paperwork in advance of the deadline to avoid the late payment fees. Students are responsible for any balance that results from losing their financial aid, scholarships, waivers, etc. during the session or semester. All registered students are advised to check their fee bill on Arrow to verify their payments and/or credits (scholarships, financial aid, waivers, etc.) have been received and posted.

To avoid the late payment fee, students must:

1. Have a zero balance by the fee payment deadline as a result of payment(s)
2. Have a zero balance by the fee payment deadline as a result of financial aid and/or scholarships and/or waivers
3. Have signed up for the online payment plan by the fee payment deadline
4. Have dropped your courses by the fee payment deadline

NOTE:

It is the student's responsibility to drop their courses if they have decided for any reason not to attend ULM. **Summer II classes dropped after Thursday, July 9, 2009 will be graded with a "W" grade and will be included in tuition and fees calculations.**

7	Tuesday	Residence halls open for Summer II move-in. Students must be registered for classes and all fees paid before checking into a residence hall.
8	Wednesday	Summer II Classes begin – University Offices open from 7:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Food services facilities open 7:00 a.m. - 7:00 p.m.
9	Thursday	Last date to add a course or making course changes (6:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. and 7:00 p.m.-12:00 a.m.). NOTE: If course load is reduced after this date, a refund is <u>not</u> applicable. A partial refund applies only for resignation. “W” grade will be issued for courses dropped after this date and course(s) will remain on the student’s schedule for fee calculation purposes.
10	Friday	Fee payment deadline for late registrants. This non-refundable fee will be assessed to students who register for classes on or after July 2, 2009 . Late Registrants have until June 10 to pay their fees. 10	Friday	No course changes (add/drops) will be available on ARROW or through the Registrar’s Office on Friday, July 10 until financial aid processing is completed. The drop function will be available beginning at 6:00 a.m. on Saturday, July 11.

14	Tuesday	Last day for full Textbook Refunds
20	Monday	Final date for resigning with a partial refund upon resignation.
21	Tuesday	Final date for removing “I” grades.
