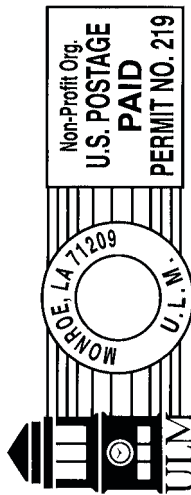
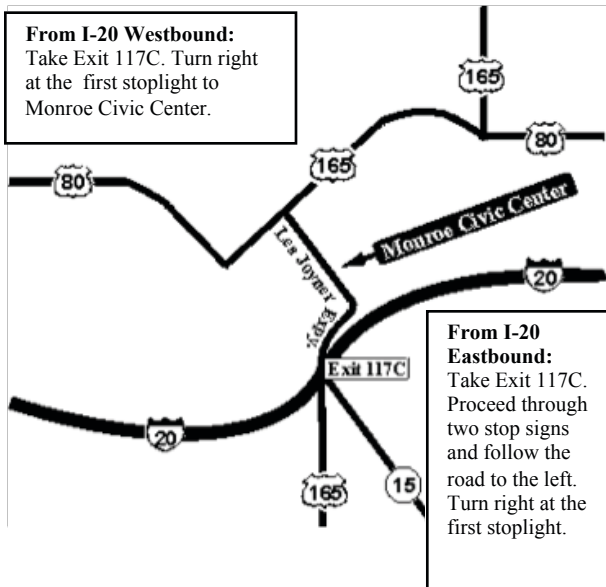


**SPEECH-LANGUAGE PATHOLOGY

Program Description:

This presentation will review the Common Core State Standards from the “lens” of the speech-language pathologist. It will help SLPs plan activities and goals that incorporate the standards in educationally relevant intervention. There will be many interactive activities throughout the day and a half. Friday’s sessions will help SLPs know their many roles in Multi-Tiered Systems of Support (MTSS). As many schools move to this problem solving model, SLPs can play a critical role in supporting MTSS teams across the educational environment.

Learning Objectives:

- Describe the standards through the “lens” of the speech-language pathologist
- Use the standards to plan activities that could be used in the classroom
- Locate the extensions of the standards for students with intellectual disabilities
- Define the role of the speech-language pathologist in Multi-Tiered Systems of Support
