



## Credit Based on ACT/SAT Scores

**Students who earn outstanding scores on the ACT/SAT may qualify for credit in freshman-level English and/or math.**

- Credit is awarded for English 101 and/or English 102 courses to students who meet the following *minimum criteria* for ACT/SAT scores earned on a single test date:
  - **English 101** (3 semester hours)  
An ACT English score of 28 or above plus an ACT Composite score of 25 or above *or* an SAT Verbal score of 630 plus a combined SAT Verbal score and SAT Math score total of 1130.
  - **English 101** and **English 102** (6 semester hours)  
A total of 65 for the combined ACT English and ACT Composite scores *or* a total of 1430 or above for the combined SAT Verbal and SAT Math scores.
- Credit is awarded for Math 111 or Math 113 courses to students (graduating May 2007 or after) who meet the following *minimum criteria* for ACT/SAT scores earned on a any test date:
  - **Math 111** (3 semester hours)  
An ACT Math score of 26 or higher *or* an SAT Math score of 600 or higher
  - **Math 113** (3 semester hours)  
An ACT Math score of 30 or higher *or* an SAT Math score of 670 or higher
