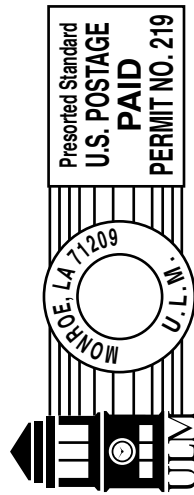

a twenty-four hour course which will partially fulfill the requirements for the Louisiana State Board Certificate of Expanded Duty Dental Assistants

Dates for Monroe, LA:
November 7, 8, 9, 2008
February 13, 14, 15, 2009
June 5, 6, 7, 2009

The course presentation will be open to those dental assistants who have been employed in one dental practice a minimum of six months as a chairside dental assistant. A certificate will be awarded for the completion of the course if the prerequisite is verified, if all sessions are attended and if a passing grade is obtained on tests covering the objectives of the course.

COURSE OBJECTIVES

Through lecture and laboratory exercises the participants will be able to:

- Remove sutures, post-extraction dressings and surgical ligature ties.
- Place or remove temporary separating devices.
- Apply cavity liners, excluding direct pulp capping.
- Place temporary restorations and post-surgical packs.
- Place, wedge, or remove matrices for restorations by the dentist.
- Place and remove periodontal dressings, except placement of the initial dressing.
- Place and remove retraction cord.
- Perform coronal polishing procedures prior to or after the placement or removal of bands, crowns, and restorations; after the removal of dressings or packs, excluding periodontal dressings and packs; after scaling by a dentist or hygienist; or prior to rubber dam placement, fluoride application or acid-etch procedures.
- Assist in monitoring Nitrous Oxide.
- Assist in rubber dam placement.
- Fabricate temporary crowns and restorations.
- Place pit and fissure sealants.

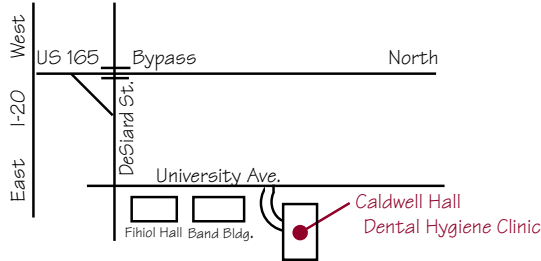
