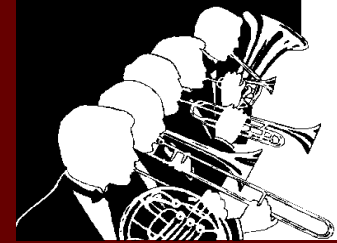

The 2011 High School Brass Day will feature trumpeter Doug Reneau, a member of the Louisiana Philharmonic Orchestra, and the Chamber Arts Brass, resident faculty brass ensemble at the University of Louisiana at Monroe.
