TALENT GRANT STANDARDS OF PROGRESS

- 1. Awards will be made for the academic year, and students will only be deleted if they fail to meet the **Minimum Standards of Progress:** 
  - Complies with all policies and rules of the talent grant sponsor.
  - Maintains a minimum overall cumulative 2.0 GPA.
  - Maintains a minimum cumulative 2.0 GPA in core requirements.
  - Complete at least six hours of core requirement classes each semester until the core is fulfilled.
  - Successfully completes a minimum of twelve (12) hours each semester.

# Failure to comply with the above conditions will cause your talent grant to be revoked.

Appeals may be made to the VAPA Talent Grant Appeals Committee for extenuating circumstances only and must be received in writing within ten (10) days of the date of the notification letter that the grant has been revoked.

- 2. Incompletes ("I" grades) must be made up, and grade reports must be filed with the Financial Aid Office in order to have the scholarship reinstated. Remedial and developmental courses are counted in hours pursued and earned in calculating the GPA.
- 3. The Grant amount may be adjusted upon renewal based upon the student's progress, his or her mentmental work, and availability of funds.

### NOTICE TO OUT-OF-STATE STUDENTS

- 1. To qualify for an out-of-state tuition waiver, you must have a 2.5 GPA in all completed high school and college work, successfully complete an audition, and enroll as a full-time student at ULM.
- 2. If you have been awarded an out-of-state tuition waiver, you must earn at least 12 hours per semester and maintain a minimum 2.0 GPA for renewal. This requirement applies to every semester, including first-semester freshman year.

# Additional Talent Grant requirements ULM Art Program

- Must be enrolled in an art concentration in the ULM Art Program as an art major.
- Membership in local or regional arts organization such as the Delta Alpha chapter of Kappa Pi, the Masur Museum of Art, Northeast Louisiana Arts Council or similar organization.
- Submission of artwork to the Annual ULM Juried Student Art Exhibition.
- Some attendance at art events and gallery openings sponsored by the ULM Art Program.
- Additional duties may encompass art-related and studio support service activities.
