- Maintain a minimum overall cumulative 2.0 GPA.
- Maintain a minimum cumulative 2.0 GPA in university core requirements.
- Make reasonable progress towards degree completion including at least six hours of university core requirement classes each semester until the core is completed.
- Successfully complete a minimum of twelve (12) hours each semester.
- Membership in the Delta Alpha Chapter of Kappa Pi International Honorary Art Fraternity. Students who do not yet meet admission requirements may become associate members.
- Submission of artwork to the Annual ULM Juried Student Art Exhibition.
- Some attendance at Gallery openings and events sponsored by the Art Program.
- Additional duties may encompass art-related and studio support service activity.

Talent Grant continuation and renewal.
