1. Mathematics:

Math 4007 and 4009 are to be offered for both Graduate credit as well as undergraduate credit.

Course Change forms for 4007 and 4009:

- We do not think these forms are necessary since they do not contain any changed material. We recommend that you move/add the information from #3, "Reasons for change," to the Catalog Change form instead. The Catalog form seems to cover this change for you. Please do leave the Undergrad. and Grad. syllabi in the packet with the Catalog Change forms.

Math 4007 Syllabus:

- Course number at top of both Undergrad. and Grad. syllabi read 407 instead of 4007. (They also still read Fall 2007.)

Catalog Change form, p.205-206 of Undergrad. Catalog:

- All course numbers and prerequisite course numbers need to be changed to 4-digit numbers.
- The description for 4009 has a lot of weird spaces in the middle of words.
- #3 should read page 206, not 200.
- Should the description for 4007 include the word "the" before calculus or is that a typo? If it needs to be changed, be sure to change it on ALL paperwork, including the Insert.

Catalog Change form, p. 59 of Grad. Catalog:

- All course numbers and prerequisite course numbers need to be changed to 4-digit numbers.
- The description for 4009 has a lot of weird spaces in the middle of words.
