

**END OF THE YEAR REPORT  
PREMEDICAL/ PREDENTAL ADVISORY COMMITTEE  
4-18-13**

Between June of 2012 and May of 2013, 13 undergraduate students were interviewed during their application process for professional school. The committee met several Fridays for at least 1.5 hours per interview. Seven students were interviewed for medical school, two were interviewed for Physician Assistant School and two were interviewed for Dental School. Two students asked for meetings with the committee to assess their current standing.

The committee chairs wrote letters for a total of 26 students, requiring about 20 hours of work for each chair. Each Chair in most cases sent multiple letters since most students apply to more than one school or program. These students included current seniors and a number of students that had graduated in previous years, but had been interviewed earlier and were now seeking admittance into a professional program.

Acceptances are categorized below and reflect the known numbers as of 4-18-13.


