STAP Committee FY22 Proposal Recommendations

Attached you will find the recent meeting minutes and proposed budget from the Spring 2022 STAP Committee meeting which was conducted on Feb. 14, 2022. The main purpose of this session was to review 7 proposals from the ULM Community for Spring 2022 funding with an approximate amount of \$100,000 available to disperse. The recommendation consists of funding for 5 proposals in the amount of \$99,894. There was also a side recommendation to redistribute approximately \$28,000 of unused SmartClassroom allocations to the purchase of 2 Microsoft Surface Hubs as a trial project in the Library 2nd floor InfoCommons.

Please review and if found acceptable, please approve by signing the minutes and recommendation spreadsheet. Information Technology will send award announcements to the applicable programs and purchasing coordination will occur immediately so as to be completed by June 30, 2022 assuming there are no delays from the respective technology vendors.
