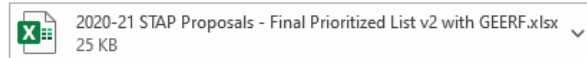

Dear STAP Committee members,

Last month, the STAP Committee proposed funding the following projects for a total cost of \$38,699.15:

- Update HMPH 124 (Peggy Lane) - \$6,400.00
- Pharmacy Mac mini lab (Marcia Wells) - \$4,821.15
- Laptops in the Classroom Cart (Elizabeth Stammerjohan) - \$27,478.00 [Tabled]

These tally up to \$38,699.15 --- I am happy to report that due to the nature of these 3 proposals, we have identified an alternate funding source for those 3 projects.

As you recall we tabled a decision on 3 of the proposals dealing with the WIFI for the CBSS Laptop Cart in Hemphill and the two proposals for the Museum. With the redirected \$38,699.15 in savings, would the STAP Committee be agreeable to supporting the following adjustments?

- Wi-Fi for Hemphill Hall (Elizabeth Stammerjohan) - \$10,000.00
- Wi-Fi for Hanna Hall and Museum of Natural History (Kim Tolson) - \$6,768.00
- Multimedia instructional facility in Hanna Hall (Kim Tolson) - \$3,906.00

These three projects tally to \$20,674 which is a reduction due to the GEERF funding opportunity that 3 proposals were eligible for. Attached is a spreadsheet view showing the adjusted funding footprint.

As a note, we did also meet with Dr. Stammerjohan and Dr. Tolson to gain further insight to their project requests. They both understood our concerns about WIFI availability and the methods they desire to engage for their respective projects did appear to be worthy. There will be some neat cross-collaboration activity evolve at the Museum – you'll want to check it out.
