DISCUSSION	 Data was provided to the ULC about library usage during the late hours (1am and 2am) available to the students this semester. Students are generally still I in the library at 2am. Keeping the Library open later has proved to be completely successful. A possible budget cut for next summer was discussed. It may be 5% of total budget. Cutting the Library acquisitions appears to be the best choice for a cut of that magnitude. The security during the late hours was brought up. Dean Smith indicated that there was one staff member and 2 students workers (carefully selected) after midnight. The ULM Police stop by and check the building – each floor – several times during the evening. There are also cameras located throughout the library that are available for monitoring by the police. Further discussion on security led to a motion by Sharon Meyer and seconded by S. Seetharama that the committee draft a memo suggesting that options be explored to provide a safer environment for students either using technology or other means. Committee unanimously agreed.
