2013-2014 END-OF-YEAR REPORT University Library Committee

The committee discussed and gave recommendations on the following issues:

- The place of the Library in the university's new strategic plan.
- Reassignment of library space for offices and classrooms following the fire in Walker Hall.
- The possibility of housing in the Library a Fall 2014 speaker series to mark the centennial of the outbreak of World War I.
- Assignment of a campus police officer to the Library during extended late hours.
- Library workshops for students.
- Promotion of collaborative projects between faculty in academic units and library faculty.
- Transforming the Library into a completely digital collection; the costs and the reassignment of space that would be necessary in such a move.
- The need to archive print copies of important documents, especially the university catalog.
- The creation of an online exam testing center to be housed in the Library and possibly made available to other institutions as a way of increasing revenues.
- Fees for binding of theses and dissertations.
