- Executive Vice President, Director of Planning & Analysis and I visited Georgia State University
- GSU had increase in retention & gained national recognition
 - Use technology to track student issues & degree audits
 - Implemented mandatory advising for first year
 - Added various checkpoints
- ULM began creation of in-house technology for same purpose

- Advising holds will be placed on all Fall 2018 Incoming freshmen for their **first three semesters**
- These Fall 2018 incoming freshmen students will be advised by the SSC.
- All other students majoring in these degrees will not have advising holds; however, they are encouraged to discuss their major with a department faculty member or Student Success Center advisor
- There is still a need for **advising loads, degree checkouts, and college advisor assignments** to track students

TALON EARLY ALERT PILOT (REPLACE GRADES 1ST EXCEPT STUDENT-ATHLETES)

- New program to replace Grades First – difference is **continuous monitoring**
- Create academic alert for missing classes, missed assignments, grades below C, etc
- Instructors remain the director of classroom management
- Instructors will receive emails at semester check points
- Automatic alerts generated by the program like term GPA < 2.0, falling below 12 hours after dropping, registering for course(s) not in curriculum, and others



















CHALLENGES

- Make sure courses are programmed correctly to avoid unnecessary overrides
- Review curriculum map's flow for students beginning in fall versus students beginning in spring
- Consider minimum requirements for programs to include processes
 - ie: required degree audits (60 & 90 cr hr); mentoring; career info
- Faculty workload – have required assignments for student contacts per above

PLAN

- Use Flightpath for advising and curriculum maps
- Use TALON for academic alerts and tracking
- Phase II beginning PREP 2019 – Phase II will include the rest of CAES and CBSS
