- your <u>SSN</u>, date of birth, filing status and mailing address from latest tax return,
- access to your email account,
- your credit card number or account number from an auto loan, mortgage, home equity loan or home equity line of credit, and
- · a mobile phone with your name on the account.

- SSN or Individual Tax Identification Number (ITIN).
- date of birth, and
- mailing address from your latest tax return
