RE: ULM Employee Holiday Schedule

Act 139 of the 1991 Regular Session of the Legislature provides that each institution of higher education shall designate a maximum of fourteen (14) legal holidays per calendar year to be observed as University holidays instead of observing the same number of State designated holidays.

Accordingly, the following University holidays are designated for 2020-2021 and will be observed without regard to otherwise designated State Holidays.

Please make this information available to all employees within your unit. Department heads are authorized to allow employees, where applicable, to work during holidays in lieu of using leave. *These are employee leave days, i.e., compensatory leave, annual leave or leave without pay as appropriate. **University offices will close at 12:00 pm on Wednesday, November 25, 2020, in observance of Thanksgiving break. Winter session classes resume Monday, January 4, 2021. All employees should report to work on Monday, January 4, 2021 following the Christmas and New Year break.
