RE: ULM Employee Holiday Schedule

Act 139 of the 1991 Regular Session of the Legislature provides that each institution of higher education shall designate a maximum of fourteen (14) legal holidays per calendar year to be observed as University holidays instead of observing the same number of state-designated holidays.

Accordingly, the following University holidays are designated for 2025-2026 and will be observed without regard to otherwise designated State Holidays.
