1.) A minimum grade of "C" or better is required in English 1001, 1002, and the first non-developmental Mathematics course.

2.) HUMANITIES (9 hours)

Nine hours must be selected from Literature, Foreign Language, History, Communication, or other courses designated as Humanities. The nine hours must contain a minimum of 3 hours of Literature.

3.) MATHEMATICS (6 hours)

Six hours must be selected at a level no lower than applied algebra.

Students may not use the following combinations to satisfy the Math requirement:

MATH 1009 and MATH 1011

MATH 1011 and MATH 1013

MATH 1012 and MATH 1013

MATH 1014 and MATH 1031

4.) NATURAL/PHYSICAL SCIENCE (9 hours)

Six hours must be from a single subject area of biological or physical science. Three hours must be from the other area (i.e., both physical and biological sciences must be taken). **Students may receive credit toward degree in only one of the following:** PHYS 1001, PHYS 2003, PHYS 2007, and PSCI 1001. **Additionally, students may not receive credit toward degree in both GEOS 1001 and GEOL 1001.**

5.) SOCIAL/BEHAVIORAL SCIENCES (6 hours)

Six hours must be selected from **Social Sciences:** Economics, Geography, Political Science and/or **Behavioral Sciences:** Psychology and Sociology. Students must take at least three hours of Social/Behavioral Sciences at the 2000 level or above.

6.) **Substitute Music Electives** - Piano lesson for Piano class.
