Interim Housing (May 17 – May 30)

Summer I Housing (May 31 – June 29) **COST:** \$350 (double) OR \$450 (private) / \$333 meal plan

- Monday, May 31 - Residence Halls open for Summer I. Students must pay all fees before checking into a residence hall. **Check-in: 1:00 p.m. – 4:00 p.m. in the Residential Life Main Office.**
- Tuesday, June 29 - *Students attending Summer I ONLY must check-out of residence halls by 12:00 p.m. Late check-outs will be assessed a daily charge.*

Summer II Housing (July 5 – Aug 3) **COST:** \$350 (double) OR \$450 (private) / \$333 meal plan

- Monday, July 5 - Residence Halls open for Summer II. Students must pay all fees before checking into a residence hall. **Check-in: 1:00 p.m. – 4:00 p.m. in the Residential Life Main Office.**
- Tuesday, Aug 3 - *Students must check-out of residence halls by 12:00 p.m. Late check-outs will be assessed a daily charge.*
