_____ **Maymester Housing** (May 13 – May 31) **COST:** \$180 (double) OR \$220 (private) / No Plan Available

- Monday, May 13 – Residence halls open for Maymester. Students must pay all fees before checking into a residence hall. Check-in: 9:00 a.m – 4:00 p.m. in the Residential Life Main Office.
- Friday, May 31 - Students attending Maymester ONLY must check-out of residence halls by 12:00 p.m. Late check-outs will be assessed a daily charge.

_____ **Summer I Housing** (June 2 – June 28) **COST:** \$350 (double) OR \$450 (private) / \$333 meal plan

- Sunday, June 2 - Residence Halls open for Summer I. Students must pay all fees before checking into a residence hall. Check-in: 9:00 a.m – 4:00 p.m. in the Residential Life Main Office.
- Friday, June 28 - Students attending Summer I ONLY must check-out of residence halls by 12:00 p.m. Late check-outs will be assessed a daily charge.

_____ **Summer II Housing** (June 30 – July 31) **COST:** \$350 (double) OR \$450 (private) / \$333 meal plan

- Sunday, June 30 - Residence Halls open for Summer II. Students must pay all fees before checking into a residence hall. Check-in: 9:00 a.m – 4:00 p.m. in the Residential Life Main Office.
- Wednesday, July 31 - Students must check-out of residence halls by 12:00 p.m. Late check-outs will be assessed a daily charge.
