4. **Approval of last meeting's minutes**
 - a. Approval of last meeting minutes as read was motioned by Senator *Sarzan* and seconded by Senator *Wilson*.
5. **Summer Chairman Report**
 - a. *Chairman Lohman welcomes everyone to Summer Senate.*
 - b. *Chairman Lohman states that she had a meeting with Mayor Ellis, President Castille, and Provost McEacharn. They talked about the potential of a partnership with Monroe Transit, which is something that Senator Cason brought up to Chairman Lohman in the spring semester. Monroe Transit is going to create a concise survey for students using Monroe Transit to have an*

ideal bus route. There is potential to have a partnership with Monroe Transit and get bus passes for our students. At the meeting, Chairman Lohman also discussed issues about the unsafe intersections surrounding campus, and they started conversation about how to get processional cross walks at the two main entrances of the University and what the next steps are.

- d. One of Chairman Lohman's main goals for summer senate is to work on solidifying new departments. She wants senators to collaborate and propose a new option to Senate in the Fall.*

These senators will be working over the summer and preparing their positions upon approval.*
- f. Chairman Lohman has picked out dates for Senate Retreat, and she wants to know senate's opinion about hosting a two-day retreat that will be fun and incorporate team bonding activities as well as learning Robert's Rules of Order and the powers that senators have.*
- g. Chairman Lohman gave senate an update on the turtle feeder. The turtle feeder is no longer jammed and planning to put turtle food in it and screw it back into the ground. Chairman Lohman is looking for a new solution for building a box around the turtle feeder and asks if Snetor Caldwell could help with building the box.*
- h. Chairman Lohman speaks about the meeting with Tommy Walpole. Mr. Walpole gave the Student Government his plan for the new Starbucks. Now waiting for updates and approvals from Mr. Walpole.*
